### Review . . .

### How do you recognize a true servant of the Gospel? (verse 10)

You Can Recognize a True Servant  
of the Gospel by Who He Serves.

#### I. A True Servant of the Gospel Pursues Truth Over Popularity

- A. The word “now” introduces a time element - "(For am I *now* striving to please men or God?")

#### II. A True Servant of the Gospel Knows and Defends the Gospel

- A. Reviewing the ABC's of the Gospel . . .

#### III. A True Servant of the Gospel Serves Only One Master

- A. A Slave has a Single Purpose – to Please his Master (Matthew 6:24)
