Justification
Sanctification

No real
distinction

Infused righteousness
Made righteous

Salvation by grace infused to the soul through baptism into the Roman Catholic Church, sacraments (the eucharist), penance, and faith cooperating with works

No real assurance is possible as the Roman Catholic is on a journey toward gaining enough righteousness to merit eternal life
Good deeds are an *a priori* evidence of justification
A final cleansing of sin in purgatory

God is not sovereign in justification or sanctification
Semi-Pelagian synergism of grace and works
