## *Justification Sanctification and Assurance*

### Justification

Imputed righteousness  
*Declared righteous*

Distinction  
blurred

### Sanctification

Salvation by grace alone through faith alone in Christ alone  
Repentance precedes faith  
The sinner must be willing to surrender all to be saved

Assurance is based on sanctification *a priori*  
some maintain that assurance is not possible

God is sovereign in justification and sanctification  
The distinction between justification and sanctification is blurred  
due to the high priority placed on holy living as it relates to assurance
